How to Effectively Handle Advice



ACKNOWLEDGE & THANK

Let the person providing the advice know that you value and appreciate their time, energy, effort, and input.

DON'T DISMISS OUT OF HAND

Avoid the knee-jerk reaction of saying 'no' without investing time to evaluate and decide.



VERIFY IMPACT & FEASIBILITY

Consider the impact the idea will have if implemented and assess the feasibility of making it happen. Make sure the impact outweighs the cost.

INVITE YOUR GUT TO CHIME IN

Pay attention to what your instincts tell you. Your experience and intuition can be very informative.



CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Reflect on who is giving the advice and their experience, understanding of the situation, and motive.



EVALUATE & SELECT

Determine if you will put the advice into practice, apply a modified version of the other person's counsel, or continue the status quo.

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
